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ROSEWOOD CUP RULES OF PLAY

DAY 1

SHAMBLE 80% HCP

Shamble:

Each golfer tees off and the best shot is selected, but from that point, each golfer plays his or her own ball until it is holed out.

Players may not improve the ball once both have played the 2nd shot. Ball must be played out as it lies (With USGA Rule exceptions).

Team score is that of the player on the team with the best individual score.

DAY 2

BEST BALL 80% HCP

Best Ball:

Each golfer hits his or her own ball throughout the round but after each hole, only the best score amongst the team members is recorded and counts as the score for the whole team for that hole.

USGA Rules Apply.

DAY 1 & DAY 2 final scores combined will determine WINNERS.





TOURNAMENT PRIZES

Winners will be determined from day 1 and day 2 scores combined.

Ties: Players will go into a 3-hole play-off (holes 16, 17, 18)
